DESCRIPTION

Emma Louise Too is a beautiful example of a Narrow boat built in the Dutch Barge Style. She was built and fitted out in 2011 by Stone Boat Builders.

The internal accommodation area includes (from forward to aft) a bedroom, bathroom, saloon, galley wheelhouse, and aft en-suite cabin. The headlining and cabin side lining is varnish T & G bead-jointed ash panels Set diagonally to the cabin side with ash faced plywood to the hull side.

Contrasting hard wood has been used for linings, trim and doors also to furniture in the bedrooms.

The forward cabin includes two fixed berths, with the saloon low level cupboards and shelving.

She is a real head turner and will be the envy of boaters on the canals while you cruise past in pure luxury.

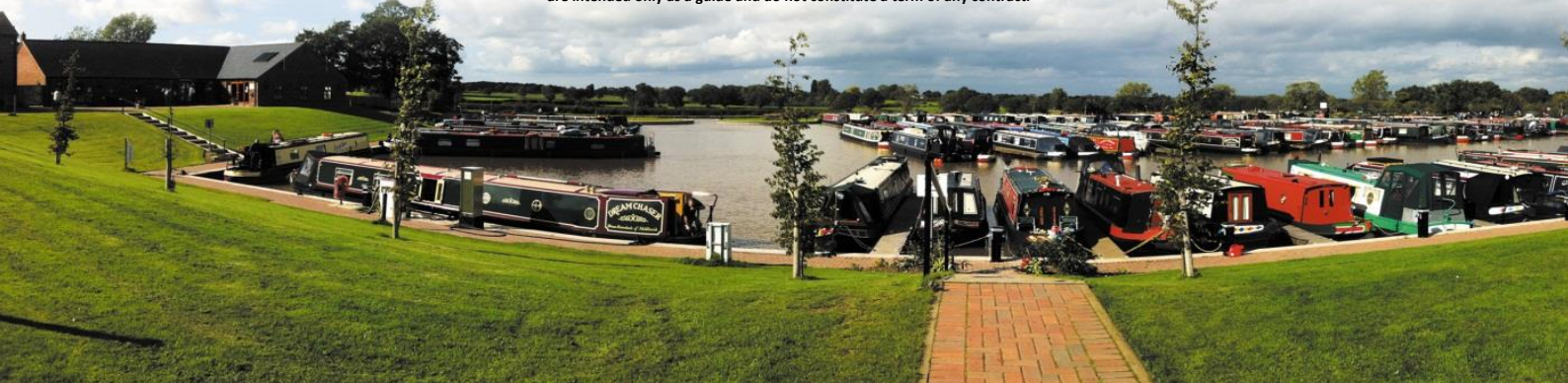
